IRS 990-Filings or Other Tax Returns

Missouri-1, Powtowmack-26, Oglethorpe-28, Crown Colony-29, Spanish Missions-31, Lone Star-32, Alabama-33, Heart of Texas-34, El Camino Real–37, Connecticut River Colony-38, Grand Assembly of the Albemarle-39, and any other Chapter that has complied with IRS regulations and are able to file a 990-N After 31 March 2025.

Please send your accepted 990-N notice from the IRS for the year 2024. From the IRS 990-N website you can print the Accepted PDF copy and save it on your computer, then attach the saved PDF file and email it to me.

Form **990-N** is due every year by the 15th day of the 5th month after the close of the nonprofit's tax year. This is May 15 for most nonprofits, which use a calendar year. You cannot file Form **990-N** until after your nonprofit's tax year ends. If your **990-N** is late, the **IRS** will send a reminder **notice** to the nonprofit's last address in its records.
